Mathematics

We will be covering a range of maths topics this term, including addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, shape, fractions, measurement and real life problem solving. We will continue with daily practice of mental maths -4,3 and 8 **times tables**, doubles and

This half term we will be learning about Judaism where the children will be looking at the beliefs within the religion, and in particular how they demonstrate their relationship with God.

PSHE

During this half term, year three will be continuing R-Time sessions, focused on our three school rules.

History

The topic this half term is 'Stone Age'. Over the next few weeks, Year three will be learning about what archaeology is and how we use it to discover historical facts about how people in Britain lived during the Stone Age.

Science

The science topics for this half term is 'Rocks'. The children will be learning to group together different types of rock based on their appearance, and describe how fossils are formed.



English

This term the children will be reading a non-fiction text called 'Pebble In My Pocket' and our Literacy lessons will be centred around the text. We will be using the text to create our own non-fiction work and it will put our Science and History work into context.

French

Children will be learning to name family members and school items in French, as well as develop their confidence with greetings.

DT

We will be researching, designing and making packing that is functionally appropriate for sweets.

PE

This term we will be learning Dynamic Balance with a cognitive multi ability focus.

Music

This half term we will be using continuing to have a weekly visit from a specialist, teaching us how to play guitar!

In ICT, the children will be selecting and using a variety of software to accomplish goals, and will recap how to stay safe on the internet.
