LITERACY

For the first two weeks of term we will be looking at poetry focusing on performing poems with rhythm. Our book for this term's literacy is 'The Princess and the White Bear King'. We will be exploring the plot, characters and story setting and will write in the style of various genres.

Phonics, Guided Reading, and handwriting will take place every day.

MATHEMATICS

We will be learning about money, place value, addition and subtraction in the context of money, weight as well as volume.

The vocabulary we would like the children to use is: sterling, pence, pounds, cost, ones, tens, hundreds, thousands, hundred thousands, how much?, change, total, altogether, heavy, light heavier than, lighter than, full, empty, more than half, less than half, half full and quarter full.

MUSIC

We will be learning that dynamics mean how loud or quiet the music is and will learn how to sing musically after warming up, sitting or standing so that we can project our sounds confidently.

GEOGRAPHY

We will be learning about different modes of transport (cars, planes, trains ect.) and discussing how we travel to places using different transport.

D.T.

We will be looking at the structures of castles and labelling them. Then we will design and make our own using a range of tools and equipment. Afterwards we will evaluate our designs.
