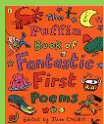

LITERACY

We will be looking at poetry this term from our Puffin book of Poems. Children explore poems using the five senses and different emotions, then write descriptive words and phrases, including similes, using their senses. Phonics, Guided Reading, and handwriting will also take place daily.



MATHEMATICS

We will learn our number bonds to 10 and 20, apply our place value knowledge to represent numbers using objects, solve addition and subtraction problems as well as compare and describe lengths and heights. We will also be learning about position, movements and turns.

The vocabulary we would like children to use is add, subtract, total, equals, hundreds, tens, ones, smaller, longer, taller, shorter, multiply, divide, turn, forwards and backwards.

COMPUTING

We will be learning about coding this term. The children will develop their understanding of algorithms and how they are implemented on digital devices.

MUSIC

We will concentrate and listen to pieces of music and describe how fast or slow the pieces of music are. We will also say what we like or dislike about a piece of music as well as how it makes us feel.

SCIENCE

Science - Plants

We will be learning about a variety of common plants and trees and will be labelling and sorting them into simple groups. The children will plant their own seed and gather and record information to answer a simple investigation question.

RE

Islam We will be learning about the stages of prayer in Islam and the children will have a chance to ask a guest speaker any questions they may have about how prayer is carried out in this faith.

HISTORY

The topic for History this term is 'changes in living memory'. We will be looking at how transport, communication and toys have changed over the decades and learning about chronological order and timelines.

ART

African Art

We will be learning about different artistic works made by craftsmen from the African culture. The children will learn about the techniques of pointillism, press printing as well as running stitch and over stitch and use them to create their own African inspired artwork.

R-Time

R time is a structured programme that builds and enhances relationships between pupils and helps children to develop lifelong social skills.

We have R time twice a week for 15 mins where the children work with a randomly selected partner from their class to carry out a fun activity.

READING

We expect the children to be reading daily. Please read with your child three times a week for at least 20 minutes daily. Please sign their reading record. Reading records will be checked to see if they are signed.
