PE:

The children will have PE on Tuesday mornings. Please make sure they have a full PE kit every week. Children are not allowed to wear jewellery on PE days.

Mathematics

We will be looking at reading, writing and interpreting maths statements that involve multiplication and division. The children will be using pictures, objects and drawing arrays to help them. We will also be focusing on number bonds to 20.

English

This term the children will be developing writing and reading skills through a range of books. They will develop their performance skills through drama lessons and write for different purposes. Daily phonics lessons will be taught to improve reading and spellings in addition to reading lessons. We will be encouraging the children to focus on improving their spellings, punctuation and grammar.

Music

We will be singing lots of songs. The children will be learning to copy a simple rhythm, working and performing as a group.

Science

This term we will be learning about plants. The children will have the opportunity to carry out investigations and gather their own results.
