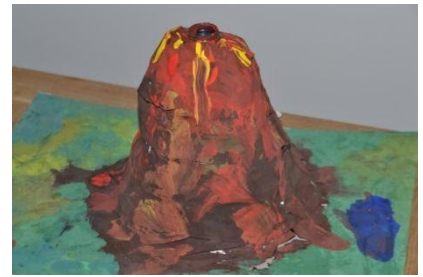


Year 3 Special Project



Next half term, we will be starting a new text linked to our history topic - Stone Age to Iron Age:

Pebble in my pocket.

During the holidays, we want you to choose and complete one of the projects below.

Next term, you will need to bring in your completed project, which will be displayed in the school.

Project ideas

1. Create a fact file about different types of rock.
2. Build a model of a volcano, dinosaur or fossil.
3. Make TOP TRUMP cards of dinosaurs. You could include: their strengths, if they are carnivore or herbivore, if they could fly, etc.
4. Make a non-fiction mini book on rocks, the Pre-historic age or the Ice age. Include a contents page and glossary. You may want to include printed pictures of real rocks.
5. Create a timeline of the history of the Earth.
You may even want to make it 3D, with flaps to lift and pop out pieces.
6. Create a stunning piece of jewellery made out of pebbles and rocks.
7. Design and make a hunting weapon for the cave people.
8. Design a menu showing what cave people ate.
9. Use paint, pastels or collage to create a river scene.

Label the parts of the river.

10. Make a landscape of one of the parts of the book.

You could make it inside a box or a shoe box and other junk modelling equipment
