Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to inform you about the arrangements for the upcoming SATs week (week beginning Monday 13th May).

Your child will sit the KS2 tests on scheduled dates set by the Standards and Testing Agency (STA). If your child is absent on a scheduled test day, they may be able to take any missed tests up to 5 school days afterwards. Your child's school must apply for a timetable variation and receive approval from STA to allow for this.

For the academic year 2023 to 2024, the KS2 tests are scheduled to take place from Monday 13th May to Thursday 16th May 2024:

Monday 13th May	English grammar, punctuation and spelling	Paper 1: Questions Paper 2: Spelling
Tuesday 14th May	English Reading	English Reading
Wednesday 15th May	Mathematics	Paper 1: Arithmetic Paper 2: Reasoning
Thursday 16th May	Mathematics	Paper 3: Reasoning

There are no tests for English writing or Science at the end of KS2, but performance in these subjects will be reported as a teacher assessment judgement. Your child's teachers will make this judgement based on your child's overall work and performance in the subject. As with the tests, this will help to indicate if your child needs more support in the subject.

To ensure all children have the best possible start to the day we will be providing breakfast Monday through to Thursday of SATs week. The children will be offered: fruit, juice, milk (or water) and a choice of cereals and toast. Even if they have had breakfast (either at home or in breakfast club) they are welcome to come along and relax with friends before tests begin. <u>This is completely free</u>, all we ask is that you send your child in no later than **7:45am** with a clearly labelled water bottle. Drop off will be at the school office.

Please do not book any appointments (eg. dentist, opticians etc) during this busy week of tests. Finally, we would urge you to encourage your child to attend the final Saturday School session on Saturday 11th May from 9am till 12pm to ensure they maximise their opportunities for making the most of the end of Year 6 and the beginning of Year 7.
