### Year 3 Curriculum



We will be covering a range of maths topics this term, including addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, shape, fractions, measurement and real-life problem solving. Knowledge of times tables and division facts will be practiced weekly using times table rock stars.



In Literacy, children will read a range of texts to broaden their creative imagination. We will be looking at different types of writing including character descriptions, balanced arguments, diary entries, as well as some role play. Children will be drafting, editing and writing tasks every half term.



In Science, year 3 will be learning about animals including humans, light, rocks, plants, forces and magnets and carrying out a range of experiments.



In History, year 3 will be learning about the stone age to iron age, the earliest civilisations and early Islamic civilisations.



Reading is taught every day and children are introduced to different genres, both fiction and non-fiction to increase their love of reading and enhance their comprehension skills. Please read with children every day and sign their reading record. Children are expected to take at least two quizzes per week and change their reading books twice a week depending on the

In Geography, year 3 will be learning about the United Kingdom, the United States weather and climate zones.

Every week children are given a piece of maths, comprehension and SPAG homework and are expected to return this on a Wednesday morning. Children also have access to TT Rockstars and MyMaths.

Resilience Days will be timetabled every half term. The children focus on transferring skills such as getting active and looking on the bright side to their everyday life.





In Art year 3 will study the work of different artists: Andy Goldsworthy, Keith Haring and Henri Rousseau as inspiration to create art pieces based on their work using different media.

In PE, Year 3 are learning a variety of different sports and activities such as indoor athletics, football, netball, gymnastics, tag rugby, fitness, quick sticks (a 'starter' form of hockey), handball, athletics and tennis
