Family members are welcome to come along and support their children, however, as you are aware, our school hall can only hold a limited number of people, so to ensure that everybody gets to see their child perform, we will allocate a maximum of **two tickets per child** on a **first come, first served** basis. The tickets will be given out by class teachers at a cost of **50p** each (**£1 for 5&6**). This money will be used to provide a wider range of playground resources for the children.

Some performances have **YC** next to them. This is to indicate that **Young Children** (roughly 0-3-years-old, who might be unable to sit quietly for the duration of the show) will be allowed at those shows. In order to provide an uninterrupted viewing experience, young children will **not be allowed at the other performances**. Sorry for any inconvenience this might cause. Older children who need to sit on their own chair count towards the **maximum ticket allocation**.

Children in **Years 5&6** will be performing one concert in the evening **outside of regular school hours**. On that date, children can stay in school until show time. Light snacks will be provided, but if parents want to provide anything else for their child, they are more than welcome to do so.

We will also be serving **mince pies** and **juice** for audiences who venture out through the cold and dark for the **evening performance!** We look forward to celebrating with you very soon.
