Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Lockdown Procedure Following Police Communication

This afternoon, we had to initiate a lockdown at Willow Primary School following communication from the police regarding an incident in the local area. We understand that such situations can be concerning, and we want to reassure you that all children and staff were safe and secure throughout the incident.

What happened today?

- As a precaution, and on the advice of the police, we enacted our lockdown procedure.
- All pupils and staff remained inside the school building while the situation in the local area was being managed.
- The children responded excellently, following all adult instructions promptly and calmly.
- At no point were pupils or staff in direct danger.

What is a lockdown procedure?

A lockdown is a standard safeguarding protocol used when there is a potential threat to the safety of pupils, staff or visitors, and it is safer to remain inside the building than evacuate. Scenarios where a lockdown may be used include:

- A potentially dangerous person or animal on the school site or nearby
- A disturbance or incident in the local community that could affect the school
- An external risk, such as a nearby chemical incident or risk of air pollution
- Police advice relating to incidents in the local area

How do we keep children safe during a lockdown?

- Registers are taken to account for all individuals.
- Blinds are drawn where possible, and movement around the school is minimised.
- The police and relevant emergency services are kept informed.
