



Junior leaders

Junior leaders are elected mostly from Year 6 and partly Year 5, across both schools. The role is used to develop pupil's leadership, social and organisational skills through opportunities to lead and innovate. This enhances well-being, confidence and pride in our school and community.

They take responsibility for various duties such as: lunchtime activities; dining hall preparation; assembly preparation and monitoring behaviour on a regular basis; presence at Parents Evening & Awards Evening; basic office administration tasks and corridor monitors. They are trained trust wide and wear the uniform of the other school (contrasting colours) with pride - so they are easily identifiable.

Head boys and girls

Both schools also promote Head boys and Head girls from the Junior Leaders who act as ambassadors for the school, showing visitors around, monitoring other 'Junior Leader' tasks, and speaking to the rest of the school in assembly. Demonstrating just how important this role is and the prestige that it carries with it.
